The Motorhead Mart Special

This 2540 lb. street/strip car has turned the quarter mile in 12.41 seconds at over 107.6 mph. The current engine, nicknamed *Killer*, is shown below during dyno testing. The previous engine made over 300 drag strip passes and accumulated 1900 street miles in the *Motorhead Mart Special*. That engine has racked up another 2500 street miles in Joe Abbin's 1950 Mercury, all with only routine tune-ups and oil changes. That's durability!



Killer Flathead

On the dyno, this engine demonstrated 335 hp. at 5100 rpm and 365 ft-lbs at 4300 rpm with 8 psi boost and 110 octane race gas. All power readings corrected to 60F and 29.92 inHg.
